## We are now at LEVEL THREE

With all the recent publicity, it should come as no surprise Black Canyon City, along with the entire State of Arizona, is facing severe drought conditions.

If <u>YOU</u> are conserving . . . keep up the good work!
If YOU haven't been conserving . . . it's imperative to start, right NOW!

We have been at "Level Two" for some time and well depths have dropped an additional 2' to 4'!! With little or no rain in sight, we have some tough months ahead, so <u>please</u> do everything you possibly can to conserve our precious water <u>each and every single day!</u>

## **MANDATORY** in Level 3:

NO washing vehicles;

NO washing decks, patios, sidewalks, parking lots, homes

NO unattended watering of trees, plants (or COWS) by hose NO filling of POOLS

We would also like to encourage EVERYONE to CUT BACK on ALL outside watering...especially if you have GRASS! Everyone can reduce the timed amount on drip systems and even eliminate a day from your normal schedule

## Hopefully we will not reach Level 4

Level 4 is defined as when well levels drop to an average of 35' BELOW ground level, or as determined by the Board based on current conditions

The District has drilled a new well and the final engineering work is being done

Together, we CAN make a difference!
